Development Approval Granted

We are excited to announce that we have been granted planning approval to build Bomen Solar Farm located near the Bomen Business Park, approximately 7km northeast of the Wagga Wagga Central Business District.

Once operational, Bomen Solar Farm will supply up to 120 megawatts (DC) of renewable energy to the grid, enough to power the equivalent of approximately 36,000 homes with clean, green energy.

Construction is expected to commence shortly and the project will be fully operational by Q4 2019. At the peak of construction, our solar farm will require approximately 200 workers on site.

We remain committed to the use of local industry and service providers in the construction of this project, particularly given the skilled local labour force and strong industrial capabilities of the region.

We are very excited to see this project enter the next phase of development and we are committed to continuing our engagement with all our project stakeholders, especially the Bomen community and our industrial neighbours.

We are collaborating with TAFE Wagga Wagga and Charles Sturt University to discuss training programs, research roles, internships, site visits, and scholarship opportunities.

We will soon be appointing our principal Engineering Procurement & Construction (EPC) contractor. We remain passionate about ensuring that local talent is employed on our solar farm so that we create a tangible benefit to the local community from the get-go and we will be partnering with the EPC contractor to deliver on this
