The Mates Gully Solar Farm is a proposed solar farm and Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) which would be located approximately 30km east of Wagga Wagga, between Borambola and Tarcutta. The proposal is being developed by Spark Renewables, a leading developer and long-term owner and operator of renewable energy projects.

Scoping Report submitted to DPE
